Aggressive Bladder Cancer – alive after 24 years

Mr. R.A. from Sweden, born 1929, started with blood in the urine in January 1984. A bladder tumor was found and removed through transurethral resection (TUR) 6.6.84. Histology showed an aggressive, poorly differentiated urothelial cancer, grade III, with infiltrative growth.

During his stay in Humlegaarden he started our treatments in June 1984 with the mistletoe preparation Helixor A. with diet and various vitamin and mineral supplements. In the middle of July 1984 an open resection of the tumor area was performed with removal of the adjacent lymph nodes. From 1984 until 1990 the patient had many local recurrences of the cancer in the bladder, treated with open as well as with transurethral resections.

In all these years he was advised removal of the whole bladder, but the patient declined.

In this period he shifted between the mistletoe preparations Helixor and Iscador QucArg. He also received injections with Echinacea. In November-December 1990 he had six weeks local bladder injections with the Calmette-vaccine BCG. Since then there has been no sign of cancer in this patient. He continued with Helixor injections until 1993-1994 and cystoscopy has been done twice every year. At the cystoscopy in July 2001 he was told that it was not modern medical treatment alone that had cured him, but also the higher powers. The implication: His cure could be considered a miracle.

The patient and his wife visited Humlegaarden on the 7th September 2001 and he told us that he was running 4-5 miles 3-4 times per week, as always. He was following a vegetarian diet and still took his vitamin-and-mineral supplements. His general condition was extremely fine and the patient and his wife have been managing a private home for disabled patients through all these years and continued to do so at this time.

At our latest contact with the patient on 14th November 2008, he was very fine and still working half-time and exercising as always. Every year he has had a cystoscopy, but finally, last year he was told by the Swedish doctors that he needs no more yearly control of his bladder, since the cancer has not recurred since 1990.
