



## Cervical cancer with good results

The patient is a Swedish woman born in 1966. In July 2003 she was diagnosed with cervical cancer stage IIA. She was treated first with two brachytherapy sessions (radioactive grains or "seeds" near the tumor) and September 2003 uterus and lymph nodes were removed. It was a poorly differentiated carcinoma with invasion in blood vessels and perineural growth. There was spread to 13 out of 37 removed lymph nodes. Then radiotherapy, 45 Gy, with simultaneous chemotherapy with cisplatin was given.

In June 2004, the patient had a dream that the cancer had come back and she insisted on an MRI examination, which in July 2004 revealed a return of the cancer on the top of the lymph glands in the peritoneum. Then she had radiotherapy for 5 weeks on the upper abdomen with 2 x cisplatin before and after radiotherapy. Completed December 2004.

In January 2006 the patient discovers a large painful tumor right above the left collarbone. The patient now has 8 radiation treatments of 4 Gy to this tumor, completed mid February 2006.

In connection with the termination of the treatments, however, a CT scan reveals multiple, up to 3 cm, lymph gland metastases left side of the neck, close to the thyroid gland and a lymph metastasis in the upper mediastinum (chest septum).

The patient began chemotherapy with Taxol / cisplatin on 15.03.06, and came to Humlegaarden on 18.4.06 for a 3 weeks stay.

We began treatment with the mistletoe compound Helixor M in increasing dosage and also treated with local hyperthermia (oncothermia), whole body hyperthermia and singulet oxygen.

The patient finishes her chemotherapy in June / July 2006 after 4 sessions and a CT scan on 15.06.2006 shows a complete remission, i.e. all visible cancer tissue has disappeared.

The patient continues her mistletoe injections.

On 11.8.2010 we received the following mail from the patient:

Hi Finn and all the wonderful staff at Humlegaarden!

Thought it was time for me to get in touch with you again, with a small "update" on my status.

I spent a total of three weeks with you at Humlegaarden in April / May 2006.

I came to you due to my second relapse of cervical cancer (metastases in the lymph). I had tumors all over the place, and felt very depressed and scared.

After three weeks with you, I regained my faith in the future, found an inner strength and a calmness that has helped me through many life crises.

The doctor here in Sweden, did not give me many chances, but you told me that I would live for a long time :-). No one knows how long we may be left on earth, but so far so it looks good for me.

I go for my regular check ups, but now only every 6 months. I currently have no evidence of regrowth of tumors, and I feel great, I'm living my dream life. I still inject Helixor every other day, and it goes really well.

Without Humlegården, without you Finn, I probably would not have been here today. You have really helped me a lot, and still today, I tell about you to those who will listen, and many are calling me, even people I do not know, to hear my story, and get information about you.

Thanks Finn, and thank you to all of you at Humlegaarden, for my life, and for my future.

We called the patient on 27.9.2010, and she told that she injects 50 mg Helixor M every other day, she also drinks green tea, and exercises quite a lot. She has 3 hard workouts a week so that she sweats, and she walks her dog every day for 1 ½ hours. She also has 2 horses.

**Conclusion:** Once again we see that the combination of good quality of life, exercise, and mistletoe can be very effective.
