Lung-Metastases

The patient, M.B., 47 year old woman from New York, stayed in Humlegaarden from 30th July- 16th August 2001. In July 1997 a tumour was removed from her right armpit and the microscopy showed infiltrating ductal carcinoma of an apocrine type, arising probably from a sweat gland. Also there were three small nodules in the lungs and a malignant lymph gland over the left clavicle. She started upon treatment with the mistletoe preparation Iscador M and later P in USA and followed a vegetarian diet. The cancer progressed slowly and when she visited HG she had multiple lung and skinmetastases and a nodule over the left clavicle. Also a skinmetastasis in the left side of the scalp. We started her on our treatment program with three whole body hyperthermias, local hyperthermia every second day, anthroposophically homeopathic medicine and changed her to the mistletoe preparation Helixor M in increasing dosage. We also started her on treatment with the copper-reducing tetrathiomolybdate and gave her 2 dendritic cell vaccines during her stay, and 3 more vaccines in October and November after her return to New York . She continued her TM treatment in USA. Our last contact with the patient took place on the 17th December, 2002, 16 months after her stay in Humlegaarden. She was doing well.
